# Toronto Rugby - 2014 Calendar & League Information

#### 1. Executive Submissions:

All clubs must submit an executive contact list to Toronto Rugby for the following positions (minimum) by Feb 28<sup>th</sup>, President, Fixtures Secretary, and Treasurer

### 2 a. Invoices – Commitment to League Play:

The TRU invoices will be sent based on the teams entered into league play in 2013 plus new declared teams. If a team is entered into league play and pulls out after the drop dead date the club will be liable for the 2<sup>nd</sup> half dues, immediately (Senior Dues \$250, U16/U18.U20 \$125)

## b. Drop Dead, Declaration, Schedule Releases & Start Dates:

Drop Dead Date for Senior Teams March 28<sup>th</sup> (declare that a team is entered)

April 4<sup>th</sup> Draft Schedule (A, B, Men, Women) April 31st Drop Dead Date for Men's C Division April 18<sup>th</sup> Full Men's & Women's Schedule Release May  $10^{th}$ Senior League Start Date Men's C Division Start Date May 24th June 6<sup>th</sup> Drop Dead Date for Juniors U18 Drop Dead Date for U15/U16 Boys May 30th June 13th Junior Schedule Release June 14th U15/U16 Boys League Start June 18<sup>th</sup> or 25<sup>th</sup> U18 Boys & U18 Girls League Start

Senior Fixtures Meetings: Sunday April 13<sup>th</sup> 10 AM.

(Make sure to have a representative at the meeting; the fall 7's series will also be discussed).

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. The C Division teams do not have to commit to be full schedule. The team can commit to 4 games, 6 games etc. however that commitment, once made will be enforced.
- 2. Payment must be received by the deadline to be eligible for entry into league play.
- 3. No changes will be made, approved or allowed to the junior schedule after it is released. If you need a date switched or moved, get it approved by the game director before that date.
- 4. If you cannot declare a junior team by the declaration date and end up getting the numbers together after that date, the game director may be able to accommodate the team.
- 5. THE REVISED FEE TO BE PAID AFTER THE DECLARATION DATE IS \$175. The entire schedule WILL NOT be disrupted.

### 3. Other Competitions Which Will Affect League Play:

The Ontario summer games (U17 7 a side) will be held in Windsor Aug 7-10. The National Festival Championships are being held Aug 6-10 and will affect U16/18 boys/girls. Rugby Ontario Cup day is August 23<sup>rd</sup> & Aug 24<sup>th</sup> and will affect U16, U18 boys and girls.

## 4. Registrations:

All clubs must have enough registered players (15 per team for seniors, 18 per team for juniors) to meet the commitments made for the entry of teams into league play.

Wednesday before the 1<sup>st</sup> League game (May 7th)

Wednesday before the 1<sup>st</sup> League game (Jun 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>)

A fine of \$150 will be levied to a club for not having the minimum number of registered players by the Wednesday before the scheduled league game. This fine will continue to apply (each week) until the club meets the minimum registration level.

### 5. Defaults:

All teams in league play will be assessed and billed a fee of \$150 per default PLUS THE REFEREE'S match fee (if they are not properly notified by the Thursday 9 pm deadline) which will be due immediately upon receipt of the invoice.

Since the clubs have sufficient time to review the schedule and have the ability at the lower levels to make less than a full schedule commitment, **ALL DEFAULTS WILL BE ENFORCED.** Once the club commits to games for a team, it must meet the commitment.

Teams with defaults are not eligible for play offs.

# 6. Score Reporting, Game Sheets (Who to Call, Where to Send):

The Following Leagues are schedule by Toronto Rugby. TR score reporting procedures are to be followed:

- Toronto Men's A, B, C Division.
- Toronto Women's A, B Division.
- U18 Boys and Girls Leagues.
- U15/U16 Boys League.
- U16 Girls League.

The following Leagues are scheduled by Rugby Ontario. RO score reporting procedures are to be followed:

• Men's Marshall & Provincial and Women's OWL leagues.
